Academic Strategy Peer Tutor (ASPT) Subject Peer Tutoring Application

Academic Strategy Peer Tutors

Academic Strategy Peer Tutors will work under the direction of the CASA staff to assist peers. Academic Strategy Peer Tutors will work one-on-one throughout the semester with assigned students and will serve as academic role models responsible for guiding, motivating, challenging and supporting students to be successful in their educational endeavors.

The Academic Strategy Peer Tutoring (ASPT) program is specifically designed to help new students navigate the transition from high school to college. Academic Strategy Peer Tutors serve as academic mentors and role models and work one-on-one with students throughout the semester to develop academic skills including: study skills, time management strategies, note taking skills, and test taking strategies.

While the ASPT program largely supports first-year students, any student can choose to work with an ASPT.

ASPTs should have a minimum **3.25 GPA** with **16 course credits preferred**. Academic Strategy Peer Tutors will be expected to attend a paid training session before the start of the semester, work a minimum of four (4) hours a week, and maintain accurate, detailed records of tutoring sessions.

One recommendation letter from a faculty member is required.

Subject Peer Tutors

Subject Peer Tutoring is available for all major subjects (biology, business, chemistry, computer science, history, geography, physics, earth sciences, and foreign languages).

Subject Peer Tutors must have minimum overall **GPA of 3.25** and **16 course credits**.

Two faculty letters of recommendation are required. One must be from the department chair of the intended tutoring subject area.
